On category A roads

 Undertake a roadside activity where the vehicle is legally parked and accessed from the non-traffic side

On category A and B roads

• Set up, maintain and remove TTM for roadside or shoulder activities where all TTM

equipment (including TTM vehicles) is outside the edgeline (or edge of seal if there is no edgeline)

- Maintain TTM at an existing static worksite when the in charge STMS is away from the worksite. The STMS must return to the worksite to carry out any required changes
- Complete inspection activities

Note: the TMO P warrant enables the holder to be in charge of and undertake inspection activities. They will not have to report to an STMS for the inspection activity.

Prerequisites:

The student must hold US31959, and demonstrate knowledge of stakeholders and operational requirements for temporary traffic management, and have sufficient on-road experience to progress to the next level of competency.
