### **Prerequisites:**

Student must hold US 31961 explain the requirements for the work site under temporary traffic management. For those wishing to go on and gain the practicing STMS Cat A or B warrant, they must first hold the practicing TMO warrant

#### **Duration:**

2 days theory – Note that if you attend this course and cannot attend Day 2 – you must complete the Cat B theory course within 2 weeks – otherwise you will need to resit the complete course again.
