

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT STMS CATEGORY (C) NP



Who should attend:

Anyone who holds the Universal STMS qualification and wants to learn about Category C roads.

Goal of the course:

Explain the requirements for the work site and the temporary traffic management for a road environment as defined by CoPTTM (US31962).

At the end of this session the STMS Category C will know:

Category C (High speed (70km/h and more), multi-lane roads)

- Risks on Cat B roading environments
- Layout distances
- Positioning signs
- Tapers
- Managing Traffic on the roadside, shoulder and lane
- Alternating flow
- Installation procedures
- Unattended and night time activities
- Pedestrians and cyclists
- Mobile operations

Prerequisites:

Student must hold US 31961, and be able to explain the requirements for the work site under temporary traffic management. For those wishing to go on and gain the practicing STMS Category C warrant, they must first hold the practicing TMO warrant.

Duration:

1 day of theory

Qualification:

- Waka Kotahi New Zealand Transport Agency do issue a NP warrant for this position which expires every 3 years
- US31962 will be credited to the individuals NZQA record of learning

What do I need to bring?

Driver's License, Passport or Birth Certificate as a form of ID, NSN number if known.
