



TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT STMS CAT (B) NP (ROADS OVER 65KMPH)

Who should attend:

Anyone who holds the Universal STMS qualification, and wants to learn about Category B roads.

Goal of the course:

Explain the requirements for the work site and the temporary traffic management for a road environment, as defined by CoPTTM (US31962).

At the end of this session the TTM Operative will know:

Category B (roads over 65kmph)

- Communication on the worksite Risks on Cat B roading environments
- Positioning signs
- Tapers
- Managing Traffic on the roadside, shoulder and lane
- Alternating flow
- Installation procedures
- Night time activities
- Pedestrians and cyclists
- Mobile operations
- Dealing with people

Prerequisites:

Student must hold US 31961, and be able to explain the requirements for the work site under temporary traffic management. For those wishing to go on and gain the practicing STMS Category B warrant, they must first hold the practicing TMO warrant.

Duration:

1 day of theory

Qualification:

- Waka Kotahi New Zealand Transport Agency do issue a NP warrant for this position which expires every 3 years
- US31962 will be credited to the individuals NZQA record of learning

What do I need to bring?

Driver's License, Passport or Birth Certificate as a form of ID, NSN number if known.
